



The *SANCTUARY PROJECT*

Work will begin on the back wall of the sanctuary on May 28, right after the morning Mass, and continue for about 6 weeks.

The *WHY*

Occasions of water damage to the wall have damaged the stucco on the wall. Causing the stucco to degrade and flake off the wall. When the stucco was first applied asbestos was a common ingredient. With the wall flaking (or in technical terms “friable”) we need to fix the wall.

The *HOW*

There are two ways to correct the issue with asbestos. 1) abatement – removing the offending material OR 2) encapsulating – completely enclosing the offending material. We will be encapsulating the entire wall. A test area is near the statue of Mary. Scaffolding will be installed to fix both sides of the wall. Consequently, the entire worship space will be sealed off.

Once the wall is encapsulated stone will be applied to the wall. We also have stained glass (that is over 140 years old) that will be mounted and backlit on each side of the crucifix. See upcoming updates for more details!
